

A note to the Access Control Consumer,

To ensure proper installation of your new American Access Systems: access control keypad, card reader, controller, telephone entry system or fire box, it is recommended that a qualified access control technician complete your installation.

Many design and installation concerns have been addressed, designed and approved by the vehicle access control industry's American Fence Association. These operation and safety design considerations are provided to you by your local, qualified installer.

There are many safety concerns that arise when designing a gate system, putting a gate in motion or automating a gate. Proper access control installation is critical to insure the performance and safety of all equipment installed on an automated gate or overhead door. The UL325 standard is provided to help with safety concerns of gates and gate operators.

AAS recommends the use of a qualified access control installer for all maintenance and installation issues. Please consult with your installation company or find a qualified installer by using local resources and your local Better Business Bureau website.
